



Dear Parent/Carer(s),

It's been a joy to welcome little faces back to school after such a long break from our building. P3/4 have done brilliantly getting their heads round the new routines and procedures in place to keep everyone safe.

As you will know from whole school communication, Bervie School is returning with a Recovery Curriculum in place which looks very different to what you and your child may be used to. We will have a focus on outdoor learning, health and wellbeing, bringing the children together and getting them used to being in the company of so many other people again! Literacy and numeracy will take place in short bursts as we build up vital learning skills.
